

Josef MOSER – CV

Josef Moser studied physics at the Graz University of Technology. He did his Master thesis already in Villach, working on the set up of the VPD methodology and graduated in 1988. He joined Infineon Technologies Austria AG, formerly Siemens Bauelemente OHG Villach, in 1989 as CVD process engineer. Later, being responsible for the management of diverse departments of different organizations, among others, for wet chemistry, ion implantation, deposition and maintenance, he gained experience in various manufacturing management positions. His intercultural skills were strongly influenced by his 6 years stay in France. In 2002 he joined EPCOS, where he managed the start of an operations organization for Ceramic semiconductors in the Czech Republic. In 2007 he joined IFAT again as head of the Quality Management in Frontend Villach. And now, in the last 7 years, he is coordinating funding projects with the focus on manufacturing innovation. In this role he also supported and managed the submission and the notification of the IFAT IPCEI projects and additionally he acts as spokesperson for the European ChipsAct.
