Isabelle Pochard obtained her PhD in physical chemistry from University of Franche-Comté (Besançon, France) in 1999. She worked thereafter as a postdoc at the University of Quebec in Trois-Rivières, Center for Research in Pulp and Paper, Canada. In 2000, she became associate professor at the University of Bourgogne (Dijon, France) where she worked on the physico-chemistry of cement nanoparticles.
