Fabiana Quaglia is a professor of Pharmaceutical Technology at the Department of Pharmacy – University of Napoli Federico II, Italy. She graduated in Pharmacy (1992), received a PhD in Pharmaceutical Sciences (1997) and a Specialization in Hospital Pharmacy (1998) from the University of Napoli Federico II. After postdoctoral training at the University of Paris-Sud, France, she became an Assistant Professor in 1999 and then an Associate Professor in 2005 at the University of Napoli Federico II. Since 2019, she has served as the Chair of the Research Board at the Department of Pharmacy, appointed as "Department of Excellence 2018-2022 and 2023-2027" by the Italian Ministry of Research. She was an Individual Membership Representative of EUFEPS (2005-2007) and an Interim Managing Editor of Biomedical Microdevices-Springer (2021–2022). She is an Associate Editor for Europe/Africa on Drug Delivery and Translational Research.

Her primary research interests focus on developing delivery platforms, ranging from the macro to the nanoscale, for treating solid tumors, lung diseases, and wound healing. She has published 150 articles in peer-reviewed journals, receiving more than 6500 citations with an h-index of 47.
