From 2015 to 2021, she directed the Department of Biotechnology, Chemistry, and Pharmacy, which became a Department of Excellence under her leadership. Prof. Santucci also coordinates the Life Sciences Macronode at the National Industry 4.0 Competence Center and the ISAAC group, focusing on AI applications in Life Sciences.

She is actively involved in various academic and research boards, including the Council of the Tuscany Life Sciences Foundation, the Pegaso Executive PhD program, and the University of Siena's task forces for Soft Skills and PhD programs. Her contributions to the fields of bioenergy, circular economy, and life sciences have established her as a leading researcher and administrator in both national and international research communities.
